Announcements/Information:

- Robert Garza joined the Sierra Native Alliance and Latino Leadership Council as an AOD Counselor. Robert was a clinician for 15 years with Merced and Stanislaus Counties. In the future, he will be providing mental health services for Sierra Native Alliance. Welcome Robert!
- Mary Star is looking to take on new clients, as is Diane Murden (8 years old and up).
- Leadership has approved authorization of additional collateral sessions in certain circumstances to enable providers to attend TDM or Wrap meetings to ensure treatment team collaboration. All require prior approval and for clinically relevant reasons.

Discussion Items:

- Medi-Cal posters and envelopes in public view

If your posters are in a binder, please ensure the binder is in clear view in your waiting room, labelled very clearly.

- Reminder to make goals on the TP specific and measurable with a baseline

Treatment plans should include a baseline to ensure that the respective client continues to benefit from services.

- Provider recruitment

Placer County is continuing to recruit for the Lincoln area, as well as bi-lingual providers and providers with specialties such as EMDR. Interested prospective providers should have at least one year clinical practice post licensure.

- Anthem Blue Cross, California Health & Wellness, and Kaiser Permanente Medi-cal Managed Care Plan Providers: Ampla Health Clinic, Community Psychiatry, Sierra Mental Wellness Group, Chapa De

Placer County Medi-cal managed care plans are; Anthem Blue Cross and California Health and Wellness. Kaiser, however, kept their healthy families clients and rolled them over to a Kaiser Medi-Cal managed care program. These programs have the responsibility of providing for mild-to-moderate mental health services in addition to their physical health services.

Ampla Health Clinic offers physical health and telemedicine psychiatry for those covered by Anthem Blue Cross and California Health & Wellness.

Community Psychiatry offers psychiatric services and currently accepts Anthem Blue Cross Medi-cal managed care plan.

Discussions ensued regarding Placer County providers not currently on these plans, and the process of becoming a provider for these plans.

- Provider audits scheduled through June 2015

All provider audits have been scheduled through the end of the fiscal year, but others will be scheduled for the rest of the calendar year.

- Provider access to CEU's

Providers are welcome to attend internal trainings and the community trainings. Most offer CEUs.
