SUBJECT: Community Forum | 2017 Immigration and Customs Enforcement Access Information Report

ACTION REQUESTED

Conduct a community forum to receive the 2017 Immigration and Customs Enforcement access information report from the Placer County Sheriff's Office.

BACKGROUND

On September 28, 2016, Governor Brown signed California Transparent Review of Unjust Transfers and Holds (TRUTH) Act, AB 2792. The TRUTH Act requires law enforcement officials provide notice and consent form to an individual in their custody that the ICE would like to interview prior to any such interview taking place and that the local law enforcement agency provide a copy of any ICE hold, notification, or transfer request to the individual and inform them of whether the law enforcement agency intends to comply with the request. The TRUTH Act further requires, beginning January 01, 2018, the local governing body in which a local law enforcement agency has provided U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement ("ICE") access to an individual during the last year to hold at least one community forum the following year.

- (1) **Responding to an ICE hold, notification, or transfer request.**
Total number of requests received: 71
This total does not include those requests received in 2017 for inmates still in custody as of 01/01/2018 that we reviewed their criminal history records and determined that we would comply and provide ICE with release date information; those totals are captured in the 2018 statistics.
- (2) **Providing notification to ICE in advance of the public that an individual is being or will be released at a certain date and time through data sharing or otherwise.**
Total number of ICE notifications or pending notifications of release prior to release: 1
- ICE notified of inmate's release date prior to release: 1
 - ICE not notified of inmate's release date prior to release: 70
 - Total inmates transferred into ICE custody: 1
 - Total ICE requests to interview the inmate: 1
- (3) **Providing ICE non-publicly available information regarding release dates, home addresses, or work addresses, whether through computer databases, jail logs, or otherwise.**
The non-publicly available information regarding work and home addresses was not tracked and was not part of the law until the passing of the Values Act. Due to the Values Act, the Jail does not release/provide this information to ICE.
Currently, we still do not track this information.
- (4) **Allowing ICE to interview an individual.**
Total number of requests to interview inmates: 2
- Interview occurred: 1
 - Interview declined: 1
- (5) **Providing ICE information regarding dates and times of probation or parole check-ins.**
This information is not known to the jail and is not something that we would track. This tracking would be the responsibility of Probation and Parole.
