WHEREAS, The California Department of Food and Agriculture (CDFA) provides for reimbursement for various programs under the direction of the Agricultural Commissioner/Sealer of Weights and Measures to help offset the costs to counties for enforcing mandated programs.

WHEREAS, Under this contract, the County will be reimbursed up to a maximum of \$50,009 each fiscal year for participating in the State's Glassy-Winged Sharpshooter program for prevention and/or control of this insect pest, which transmits Pierce's Disease to grapevines. The State first began contracting with Placer County for this program during the 1999 – 2000 fiscal years.

WHEREAS, This revenue reimbursement is for an ongoing program and has no impact on the General Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, THAT:

The Board of Supervisors authorizes and directs the Agricultural Commissioner/Sealer to sign State contract #17-0453-028-SF in the amount of \$100,018 with the California, Department of Food and Agriculture, for reimbursement for Pierce's Disease Enforcement Program for Fiscal Years 2018 - 19 AND 2019 - 20.
