ACTION REQUESTED

Approve appropriation of \$750 in Revenue Sharing monies to KidsFirst as requested by Supervisor Weygandt (\$250) and Supervisor Holmes (\$500).

BACKGROUND

In approving the following contributions, the Placer County Board of Supervisors finds that each and every approved contribution serves a public purpose by promoting the general welfare of the County and its inhabitants therefore a benefit results to the County.

The Board of Supervisors is being asked to approve appropriations to KidsFirst for its efforts to promote child abuse prevention. Since its inception in 1989, KidsFirst has provided child abuse prevention services to more than fifty thousand children. Each month KidsFirst helps to strengthen and empower nearly 300 families by providing them with the tools they need to thrive. The organization offers assistance with health insurance enrollment, referrals to community resources, therapeutic services and youth and family activities. The funds received will be used to help KidsFirst to continue to provide these services to the community.
