ACTION REQUESTED

Approve appropriation of \$1,000 in Revenue Sharing monies to The Salvation Army of Auburn as requested by Supervisor Holmes.

BACKGROUND

In approving the following contributions, the Placer County Board of Supervisors finds that each and every approved contribution serves a public purpose by promoting the general welfare of the County and its inhabitants, therefore a benefit results to the County.

The Board of Supervisors is being asked to approve an appropriation to The Salvation Army of Auburn. This organization helps support those in need in our community by providing meals, lodging, and social outreach events, including an annual Thanksgiving Dinner. This event brings together hundreds of volunteers who prepare the entire Thanksgiving meal and serve it to those in need. Home deliveries of the Thanksgiving meal are also made to approximately 300 people who are unable to get to the dinner. The funds received with this Revenue Sharing request will provide continued support of community outreach events.
