



WHEREAS, Placer County is home to a thriving mandarin orange industry; and

WHEREAS, the Asian Citrus Psyllid is a harmful invasive pest that is responsible for vectoring
the citrus greening disease that is 100% fatal to citrus trees; and

WHEREAS, the Asian Citrus Psyllid has been rapidly spreading throughout southern and
central California and was also recently detected in Placer County in the City of Lincoln; and

WHEREAS, the Agricultural Commissioner is responsible for preventing the introduction of
harmful invasive pests within Placer County; and

WHEREAS, the California Department of Food and Agriculture proposes to contract with Placer County for the purpose of offsetting County costs of conducting a trapping program to detect and monitor the presence of the Asian Citrus Psyllid.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Placer approves and authorizes the Agricultural Commissioner to sign Contract No. 17-0428-008-SF with the California Department of Food and Agriculture for reimbursement in the amount of \$83,370.00 for Asian Citrus Psyllid detection trapping.
