SUBJECT: MHSA Full Service Partnership Contracts

ACTION REQUESTED:

Approve agreements with Placer Independent Resource Services, Inc. (\$119,475), Child Abuse Prevention Council of Placer County, Inc. (\$139,725), Health for All, Inc. (\$155,925), and Whole Person Learning (\$109,350) for participation in the Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) Full-Service Partnership from October 10, 2006 through October 9, 2008 in an aggregate amount of \$524,475 for the 2-year contract term, and authorize the Director of Health and Human Services to sign the agreements and subsequent amendments.

BACKGROUND:

On November 2, 2004, California voters passed Proposition 63, the Mental Health Services Act, establishing a state personal income tax surcharge of 1% on the portion of taxpayers' annual taxable income that exceeds \$1 million. The purpose of MHSA is to expand county mental health services to children, adults and seniors with severe mental illnesses who cannot obtain services through other funds, and to fund prevention and early intervention services, innovative programs, human resource development, and capital facilities and technology improvements.

During the outreach phase of the MHSA planning process, the focus was on reaching underserved individuals, families and groups who are not receiving services through community partners and stakeholders. The resulting workgroup, consisting of these individuals and organizations, recommended a Full-Service Partnership (FSP) approach, implemented by certain community-based organizations with expertise in the working with the target populations, specifically adult, older adult, and transitional age youth.

Services to be provided include intensive case management, after-hours urgent care services, and field based services to contact clients in their existing environments, including other community based organizations' offices, skilled nursing facilities, primary residences of enrollees, hospitals, other County office/clinic locations, shelters, homeless locations as identified by MHSA staff, and the Placer County Jail or other detention facilities.

These agreements were recommended for your approval by the Mental Health, Alcohol and Drug Advisory Board during its meeting of September 25, 2006.

FISCAL IMPACT:

These contracts are fully funded with budgeted State MHSA funds. There is no County general fund contribution required.
