ACTION REQUESTED

Approve a resolution authorizing Bradford R. Fenocchio, District Attorney, to submit a proposal and execute the grant award agreement for the Placer County Automobile Insurance Fraud Program for FY 2006/2007.

BACKGROUND

The District Attorney's Office has operated a Department of Insurance grant funded program entitled the Placer County Automobile Insurance Fraud Program. Placer County is eligible to receive \$18,451 in funds from the Department of Insurance. A resolution must be approved in order to receive approval and funding to operate the Automobile Insurance Fraud Program in Placer County. The Automobile Insurance Fraud Grant Program is designated to assist district attorneys in the prosecution and elimination of organized automobile fraud activity.
