



Bulletin Board Listings - CAPCOA GHG Rx

Listings on the Bulletin Board are primarily Buyers who are seeking to purchase credits to hold, or retire and offset their GHG emissions. They may include individuals or companies. Traders/brokers/retailers may also be listed as buyers on the GHG Rx. Parties seeking funding to develop GHG credit funding projects may also be listed on the Bulletin Board. Buyers or other parties wishing to be listed on the GHG Rx Bulletin Board may apply to CAPCOA, the GHG Rx System Administrator or their local air district. These requests may also be submitted online on the CAPCOA GHG Rx.

- The following information must be included with each request to list a buyer¹:
 - Buyer: Individual name or Entity name: Thomas Gateway LLC
 - Location of emissions offset needed (address, city, county, state): 1335 Pinole Valley Road, Pinole, Contra Costa County, CA 94564
 - Amount of GHG credits to purchase in MTCO_{2e}: 788 MTCO_{2e}
 - Brief description of project needing credits and any potential requirements for the purchase (e.g., type of project, cost limitations, area desired for the purchase offsets): Medical Office Building
 - Contact Name: Dave Thomas
 - Contact Phone Number: 925-945-6266
 - Contact Email address: dthomas@tiogaconstruction.com
 - Commitment to notify the Participating District when the Buyer has completed the purchase or no longer wishes to be listed on the GHG Rx.
 - "I, David Thomas [insert Contact Name], agree to notify Placer County Air Pollution Control District [insert name of Participating District] within fifteen (15) days of the purchase of the GHG credits. I also agree to notify Placer County Air Pollution Control District [insert name of Participating District] within thirty (30) days if I no longer wish to be listed on the GHG Rx as a buyer seeking credits to purchase."
