BACKGROUND/COMMUNITY BENEFITS

The Board is being asked to approve Revenue Sharing funds for the Placer Land Trust Conservator Award Dinner. This event took place on April 15, 2006. It is an annual event that honors those who have contributed considerably to the conservation of land and natural resources available in Placer County.
