ACTION REQUESTED / RECOMMENDATION

Approve project specifications and authorize the Department of Public Works to advertise for bids.

BACKGROUND / SUMMARY

The Department of Public Works performs various surface treatments on maintained public roadways to protect, preserve, and extend their useful lives. The selection of roads for surface treatment is typically a function of the road condition, traffic volumes, and funding. Placer County received federal funds to construct an asphalt concrete overlay on roads functionally classified as "Urban." Only a small portion of Placer County's maintained miles receive the urban classification, and for this project, we chose to focus the funds one road in order to gain the best economy of scale.

This project, totaling approximately 2.5 miles, includes the following road:

ENVIRONMENTAL

This project is Categorically Exempt from the provisions of CEQA as a Class I exemption, Section 15301 (c) "Maintenance of Existing Facilities." A Notice of Exemption was posted on June 17, 2005.

FISCAL IMPACT

Funding is available in the 05/06 Road Construction Budget for Project No. 2846 "Federal Overlay." The County will receive approximately \$602,004 in Federal Transportation Funds and a Local Match of \$77,996 from the County's Road Fund.
