BACKGROUND/COMMUNITY BENEFITS

In approving the following contributions, the Placer County Board of Supervisors finds that each and every approved contribution serves a public purpose by promoting the general welfare of the County and its inhabitants therefore a benefit results to the County.

The Board of Supervisors is being asked to approve appropriations to help *The Salvation Army* fund the printing costs of the “Panhandler Solutions Pocket Guide”. The Salvation Army is working in partnership with the Placer County Sheriff’s Office, the Auburn Police Department and other community based organizations to print and distribute these guides within the community. This effort is focused on directing citizens to organizations that are dedicated to serving the homeless and individuals and families in need as an alternative to giving money directly to panhandlers. Statistics show that every dollar given to a panhandler translates to seven dollars in expenses related to officer time, incarceration, and other community impacts. These guides also provide valuable contact information to anyone in need regarding services that are available in the County. These guides are provided to merchants and citizens free of cost and are already making a positive impact in the Auburn area. Funding received will be utilized by The Salvation Army and its partners in this project to fund printing of the “Panhandler Solutions Pocket Guide”.

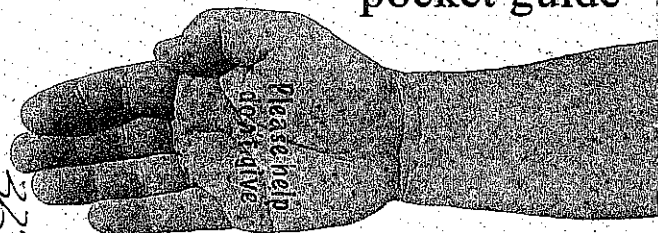
