NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Placer County Department of Facility Services (Discharger) operates the Placer County Sewer Maintenance District 3 Wastewater Treatment Plant (Facility). On 31 May 2013, the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board adopted Waste Discharge Requirements (WDR) Order R5-2013-0076 that included final effluent limitations for the Facility's effluent discharges to Miners Ravine. Cease and Desist Order R5-2013-0089 (CDO) was also adopted by the Central Valley Water Board on 31 May 2013. The CDO required the Discharger to complete tasks that would lead to compliance with final effluent limitations in WDR Order R5-2013-0076 by 31 December 2014. In 2013 and 2014, the Discharger completed work to tie into the City of Roseville collection system so that all wastewater formerly treated at the Facility will be transferred to and treated by the City of Roseville Dry Creek Wastewater Treatment Plant. On 31 December 2014, the discharge to Miner's Ravine ceased. Decommissioning of the Facility will be completed on 27 March 2015, and then the Facility will no longer discharge or have the ability to discharge to Miners Ravine.

Therefore, the Central Valley Water Board will consider rescission of WDR Order R5-2013-0076 (NPDES No. CA0079367) and CDO R5-2013-0089.

Only designated parties will have these rights: to call and examine witnesses; to introduce exhibits; to cross-examine opposing witnesses; to impeach any witness; and to rebut the evidence against him or her. All other persons wishing to testify or provide comments are interested persons and not designated parties. Such interested persons may request status as a designated party for purposes of this hearing by submitting such request in writing to the Board no later than **15 March 2015**. The request must explain the basis for status as a designated party and in particular how the person is directly affected by the discharge.

Persons wishing to comment on this noticed hearing item shall submit testimony, evidence, if any, and/or comments via email to **RB5S-NPDES-Comments@waterboards.ca.gov**, attention **Gayleen Perreira** or in writing to the Central Valley Water Board no later than **5:00 p.m. on 15 March 2015**. Written evidence or comments submitted after 5:00 pm on **15 March 2015** will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party.

All designated parties and interested persons may speak at the Central Valley Water Board meeting, and are expected to orally summarize their written submittals. Oral testimony and cross examination will be limited in time by the Board Chair.
