What We've Learned

This past winter was wetter than the last several, but the amount of rain and snow we received in California was still slightly below average.

One average year of rainfall doesn't protect us from future dry years.

Water use in Sheridan this year has been higher than any of the past three drought years.

Conservation Requirements

Don't water when it's raining, or within 48 hours of a rain event.

Don't hose off driveways and sidewalks.

Use a shut-off nozzle when washing your car.

Make sure water features and fountains have a recirculating system.

Don't cause runoff when you're watering.
