**ACTION REQUESTED**

Receive a presentation announcing the public is invited to the fourth annual Employee Art Show to be held November, 29, 2016 through February 28, 2017.

**BACKGROUND**

The annual art show is administered by a committee composed of County employees and seeks to foster engagement and connection between employees and the community we serve. The committee recruits employee artists and collaborates with various county departments as well as PlacerArts to plan and curate the show.

Participation in the show creates a sense of community and enriches the participants both personally and professionally. Participating provides opportunities for social interaction, recognition and networking with other County staff, community members and organizations.

In addition to the art submitted by employees, the show will feature a guest submission from the Placer County Youth Commission called the Hexagon Project. The commission members are appointed by the Board and were encouraged by Substance Abuse Prevention Advisor, Kara Sutter from our Placer County Children's System of Care to propose the project to the committee for consideration. The hexagon project is displayed at the Domes with a detailed description of the leadership art project.

Last year, more than 30 employees entered over 70 pieces of art in a variety of mediums including photography, painting, sculpture and other mixed media. This year's show will include multiple venues countywide.
