SUBJECT: Amendment to Latino Leadership Council, Inc. Contract

ACTION REQUESTED

Approve the first amendment to contract CN005788 with Latino Leadership Council, Inc. to provide expanded prevention and early intervention services for Latino individuals, to increase the total compensation by \$87,534 for a revised aggregate amount of \$534,331 (no net County cost) from July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2017 and authorize the Director of Health and Human Services to sign the resulting amendment, and subsequent amendments not to exceed 10 percent of the total contract amount, consistent with the current agreement's subject matter and scope of work.

BACKGROUND

In response to a competitive grant opportunity, the Children's System of Care (CSOC) and its partners were invited by the County Sheriff's Department approximately two years ago to deliver Trauma Informed prevention and early intervention services, which have effectively served some 250 families each year.

Law enforcement officers are often the first to encounter families experiencing a host of life challenges, including substance abuse, domestic violence and caregiver strain, all of which can cause trauma to those involved. The Sierra Native Alliance (SNA) and Latino Leadership Council (LLC) partners, working with CSOC, have been delivering substance abuse, counseling, group therapy and community-based in-home supports to youth and families identified by the Sheriff's Department supported in part by these grant-funded dollars. This amendment is being requested in order to utilize these grant funds for this fiscal year.

This collaborative program including LLC, SNA, CSOC and the Sheriff's Department continues to be supported by the System Management Advocacy and Resource Team, including the Probation Department and local dependency court partners.

FISCAL IMPACT

The additional expenditure of \$87,534 is funded with Federal dollars and is included in the FY 2016-17 Final Budget.

The contract amendment is on file with the Clerk of the Board for review.
