**BACKGROUND/COMMUNITY BENEFITS**

In approving the following contributions, the Placer County Board of Supervisors finds that each and every approved contribution serves a public purpose by promoting the general welfare of the County and its inhabitants therefore a benefit results to the County.

The Board of Supervisors is being asked to approve appropriations to help support the Tommy Apostolos Fund “*Annual Dinner-Dance Fundraiser*” being held on April 28, 2012 at the Roseville Sports Center. In 1988, in memory of Tommy Apostolos, the Apostolos Family, the Roseville Police Department, Roseville Telephone Company and Roseville Elementary Schools joined together to take ten needy children shopping. This program has grown to serve over five hundred children from the Roseville School Districts each year allowing them to start school in new clothes and shoes. In total, the program has afforded thousands of needy children the opportunity to shop for new clothes, which they could not afford to do otherwise. In the summer and at Christmas, the children are accompanied by adult volunteers who spend \$125 per child on clothes. The funds designated towards this popular event will help offset the costs associated with this fundraising event.


