SUBJECT: **Authorize the Chief Probation Officer to sign a memorandum of understanding to allow for the Probation Department to share a facility with Placer County Office of Education at the Youth Resource Center in Roseville's Sundown Education Center.**

ACTION REQUESTED

It is respectfully requested that your Board authorize the Chief Probation Officer to sign the attached memorandum of understanding. The memorandum of understanding would allow the Placer County Probation Department to enter into an agreement for facilities and services with the Placer County Office of Education at the Youth Resource Center in Roseville's Sundown Education Center, in support of the Juvenile Justice Crime Prevention Act (JJCPA), as required by the Comprehensive Multiagency Juvenile Justice Plan (CMJJP) funding allocation.

BACKGROUND

The Juvenile Justice Crime Prevention Act has provided funding for Placer County to implement programs that will impact juvenile justice throughout the County since 2001. The Youth Resource Center which was established in 2001 provides essential educational and life skills programs to at risk children in our community. While this facility is located in Roseville, services are provided to youth from throughout western Placer County. This memorandum of understanding continues the formalized relationship between the County and the Office of Education in regard to activities and expenses related to our shared facility at the Youth Resource Center. The Juvenile Justice Coordinating Council recommended the County's Comprehensive Multiagency Juvenile Justice Plan (CMJJP) in accordance with the State's funding allocation in April of this year. The CMJJP includes the services to be provided through the Youth Resource Center in Roseville. This agreement is funded 100% with State monies through the Juvenile Justice Crime Prevention Act. Historically, this agreement has resulted in expenditures that have not exceeded \$75,000.

FISCAL IMPACT

This memorandum of understanding will not impact the Probation Department budget, as the expenses incurred as a result of this MOU have already been included in the budget the Board has approved for the current fiscal year. There is no General Fund impact as a result of this MOU, as all monies expended for this MOU are Juvenile Justice Crime Prevention Act monies provided by the State.
