SUBJECT: Engineering / Permission to Advertise / Dollar Drive Bus Shelter

ACTION REQUESTED

Approve the project plans and specifications for the Dollar Drive Bus Shelter and authorize the Department to advertise for bids.

BACKGROUND

The Dollar Drive Bus Shelter will be located on the south side of Highway 28, just west of Dollar Drive, 2.5 miles east of Tahoe City.

The current facility is a deteriorating plywood structure that needs to be improved to provide an improved staging area for our bus patrons waiting for the bus to arrive.

The proposed shelter will be built near the footprint of the existing structure, and in front of the new structure, a 5 foot wide sidewalk will be constructed including ramps that comply with applicable Americans with Disabilities Act criteria. An expanded bus turnout will allow buses to pull off the highway to avoid blocking the Class 2 bike lane.

ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE

This project is categorically exempt from the provisions of CEQA under the following sections: Section 15301, Existing Facilities, Class 1; Section 15303, New Construction or Conversion of Small Structures Class 3.

FISCAL IMPACT

The total project cost is estimated to be \$80,000 with construction costs estimated at \$65,000. This project is budgeted in the FY 2016-17 Department of Public Works and Facilities Final Budget, Bus Stop Improvements (PC2822), and is funded through a California Air Quality grant, county transient occupancy taxes, and county traffic mitigation fees.
