SUBJECT: Successor Agency Contracts for FY 2019-20

Action Requested

Authorize the Purchasing Manager to renew and execute third party service contracts for the Successor Agency with Burke, Williams & Sorenson, LLP for Legal Services in the amount of \$50,000; Gensburg and Sons for Snow Removal and Maintenance in the amount of \$12,000; Goodwin Consulting Group for Bond Services in the amount of \$10,800; Rock and Rose for Property Maintenance in the amount of \$12,000 and Amtec for Rebate Computation for Placer County Redevelopment Agency Bonds in the amount of \$5,000 for the period of July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020.

Background

The former Placer County Redevelopment Agency and the Successor Agency have used a number of contractors for services. As the Successor Agency winds down operations, contract services are required. The contracts are largely for the purposes of activities associated with property sales and the wind-down of Successor Agency operations.

In order to continue the contractual activities itemized above, staff requests the Successor Agency Board authorize renewal and execution of the service contracts for one year, through June 30, 2020. The obligations associated with these contracts are currently listed on the Successor Agency's Recognized Obligation Payment Schedule (ROPS) to be approved by your Board January 08, 2019. The ROPS will be considered by the Placer County Consolidated Oversight Board on January 16, 2019

FISCAL IMPACT

Funding for these contracts is currently listed on the Successor Agency's ROPS for the period of July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020.
