Defining Community Values

The following values were identified by community members at Workshop 1:

- Avoid traffic congestion – through traffic
- Avoid more traffic lights – too closely spaced
- Speed limits encourage more traffic (lacking enforcement)
- Avoid higher density projects and rezones
- Improving roads increases through traffic
- Safety – bikes & pedestrians need more facilities
- Transit – buses to/from Folsom, Roseville, major employers
- Preserve value of rural area (Quality of life)
- Safety – speed, enforcement, number of cars
- Speed – prefer consistency of speeds over high speeds with stop lights

- Roundabouts – generally supported over stop signs, education, roundabouts with signals – England – lessons learned
- Evaluation of left turn lanes – are they needed? Protected/Permissive
- Education of school community on speeds
- Quarry Ponds – U-turns on Douglas Blvd/Berg, driveway markings are confusing, speeds
- New roads should be safer roads
- Avoid indirect effects of wider roadways, specifically litter and wildlife strikes
