Salvage Yard Training Requirement

- It is a requirement of the Carl Moyer Program Guidelines that at least one person at each participating salvage yard location receive training on PCAPCD's Moyer Program. This presentation will count towards the training requirement. Once this training has been completed, please follow the instructions on the last slide, and email/fax to the PCAPCD. PCAPCD Salvage Yard Agreement

- In order to participate in the Moyer Program, salvage yards are required to enter into an agreement with the PCAPCD
- Salvage yard agreements are available on the PCAPCD's website, in person, and via email/mail
- Agreements clearly outline the requirements of salvage yards and the PCAPCD and help to clarify responsibilities

Salvage Yard Requirements

- The role of a salvage yard, in the Moyer Program, is to destroy off road equipment and engines which receive a grant for replacement to ensure that emission reductions from the project are permanent
- Salvage Yards must have a valid business license within the State of California for at least two years
- Each salvage yard location must have at least one person who has completed PCAPCD's training
- Be in compliance with all regulations
- Enter into an agreement with the PCAPCD in order to participate in the PCAPCD's Moyer Program

Salvage Yard Requirements

- Salvage Yards play a key roll in ensuring that Moyer Program requirements for projects are met
- Salvage Yards are required to:
 - Destroy old equipment within 60 days of receipt
 - This includes destroying both the equipment and engine as defined in the Moyer Guidelines
 - Take photographs of the destroyed equipment and submit them to the PCAPCD within 10 days of destruction
 - Detailed requirements are outlined in the salvage yard agreement and the Carl Moyer Guidelines
