SUBJECT: Contract with California Forensic Medical Group, Inc. for Inmate Healthcare Services

ACTION REQUESTED

1. Approve the award of Request for Proposals No. 10703 to California Forensic Medical Group, Inc. (CFMG) to provide Inmate Health Services.
2. Approve the resulting contract with CFMG, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$37,357,020 for the period of July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2023 and authorize the Director of Health and Human Services to sign the contract with Risk Management and County Counsel concurrence, and to sign any subsequent amendments up to \$100,000 consistent with subject matter and scope of work with Risk Management and County Counsel concurrence.
3. Authorize the Director of Health and Human Services the option to renew the agreement for two subsequent two-year periods, and to execute the agreement with Risk Management and County Counsel concurrence and amendments up to \$100,000, consistent with the current agreement's subject matter and scope of work with Risk Management and County Counsel concurrence.

BACKGROUND

Inmate healthcare services are required to be provided within the Placer County Jail and Juvenile Detention Facility. These services include primary medical care, dental care, pharmaceuticals, mental health services, acute hospital care and specialty care to a current monthly average population of approximately 735 inmates and juvenile wards. The contract provides for a base population of 700 adult inmates and juvenile wards but can be expanded to reach the jail capacity through use of per diem charges on actual census each quarter.

Historically, the additional cost for the quarterly average daily populations (ADP) adjustments and the annual cost of living adjustments have not been included in the overall contract amount. These estimated costs are now included in the overall contract amount and account for approximately \$913,645 of the overall increase (\$18,915 annual or \$75,659 Contract Term for ADP; 3.2% annual CPI adjustments estimated at \$838,016 for the term of the contract). Staffing levels have been increased by 9.825 FTE to augment services in physical health care, psychiatric services, integrated health and care coordination services and dedicated onsite leadership. The staffing increases were agreed upon by County stakeholder representatives and were deemed as necessary to decrease risk and maintain good outcomes. With this contract, the provider will be submitting routine monitoring reports that will assist the county in monitoring the effectiveness and cost of services.

CFMG has been a long-term high performing contractor in Placer County as evidenced by its demonstrated ability in running the program and success in retaining Institute for Medical Quality (IMQ) certification for the jail and will be pursuing National Commission on Correctional Health Care Accreditation (NCCHA). Risk Management concurs that CFMG has reduced the County's liability through the transfer of risk in this contract agreement. The Placer County Sheriff's Office, Probation Department, and the County Executive Office support this contract.

FISCAL IMPACT

Funding for this contract is through the County General Fund and is included in the Sheriff's Office and Probation Department's FY2019-2020 Budgets. Additional annual cost of this contract term will be included in the annual proposed budgets for the Sheriff's office and probation Departments.
