


Placer County Bear River Day Use Area and Campground

DIRECTIONS TO BEAR RIVER DAY USE AREA/CAMPGROUND

Take the West Weimar Crossroads exit off Interstate 80. Go north 1.5 Miles, turn right on Placer Hills Road to Plum Tree Road (2.5 mi.). Turn left on Plum Tree Road to Park/Campground. Parking Lot is on the left, go through gate to campsite. Overflow parking is available in the Day Use area near the gate. Trailer or recreational vehicles are not recommended in the campground due to poor access. The facility consists of pit toilets, picnic tables and river access.


