SUBJECT: California Department of Public Health - HIV Surveillance Program Grant Agreement

ACTION REQUESTED

Approve the grant agreement with the California Department of Public Health to administer the County HIV Surveillance Program for the period from July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2024, in an amount not to exceed \$75,200 and authorize the Director of Health and Human Services to sign the agreement with Risk Management and County Counsel concurrence, and to sign amendments not to exceed \$7,520 consistent with the agreement's subject matter and scope of work with Risk Management and County Counsel concurrence.

BACKGROUND

This 2019-24 Grant Agreement recently received from the State begins the first year of a five year agreement term. This funding maintains the County's ability to administer the HIV Surveillance Program, ensure the planning, development, and implementation of HIV surveillance activities in the County.

HIV surveillance activities focus on five goals: Maintaining infrastructure for HIV surveillance; Collecting and submitting accurate, complete, and timely HIV surveillance data to the CA office of AIDS; Maintaining data security and confidentiality; Program management and coordination; and Collaboration with partners to respond to the HIV epidemic.

FISCAL IMPACT

The grant amount of \$75,200 is funded with State Funds.
