

20 PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that on November 1, 2019, at 11:00 a.m. or as soon thereafter as
21 this matter may be heard in Department 28 of the above-entitled court located at the fourth floor of
22 Gordon D. Schaber Sacramento County Courthouse, 720 9th Street, Sacramento, California 95814,
23 petitioner BRETT D. HOLT will bring on for hearing his Petition for Writ of Mandate commanding
24 the California Public Employee's Retirement System to release the records requested under the
25 California Public Records Act.

6 exhibits, the declaration of Renju Jacob, any forthcoming reply papers, the records and files herein,
7 and on such evidence and argument as may be presented at the hearing of the motion.

8 Pursuant to Local Rule 1.06(A), the court will make a tentative ruling on the merits of this
9 matter by 2:00 p.m., the court day before the hearing. The complete text of the tentative rulings for
10 the department may be downloaded off the court's website. If the party does not have online
11 access, they may call the dedicated phone number for the department as referenced in the local
12 telephone directory between the hours of 2:00 p.m. and 4:00 p.m. the court day before the hearing
13 and receive the tentative ruling. If you do not call the court and the opposing party by 4:00 p.m. the
14 court day before the hearing, no hearing shall be held.
