## **Power outages may be needed for wildfire safety**

### **Message from PG&E:**

Weather conditions, including potential fire risk, have been forecast that may impact electric service to portions of our service area. If these conditions persist, PG&E may need to turn off power for safety in nine Northern California counties starting late afternoon and into the evening on Monday, September 23. Power will remain off until weather conditions improve and it is safe to restore service. Please note that outages could last for multiple days.

### **Locations for potential PSPS outages**

The potential Public Safety Power Shutoff could affect about 124,000 customers in the following communities:

Placer county: 22,180 (including 932 medical baseline customers)

### **Community Resource Centers**

To support customers in the potentially impacted counties, PG&E will open Community Resource Centers in multiple locations on Tuesday, September 24, at 8 a.m. The centers will be open during daylight hours only and will provide restrooms, bottled water, electronic device charging and air-conditioned seating for up to 100 customers each.
