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THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF PLACER, STATE OF CALIFORNIA,  
DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

**WHEREAS**, California Government Code Section 8630 provides that a local emergency may be proclaimed by the governing body of a city, county, or city and county, or by an official designated by ordinance adopted by that governing body, and

**WHEREAS**, Government Code Section 8630 was amended, effective January 1, 2019, to change the time period in which a local emergency must be reviewed by the governing body from every 30 days to every 60 days, and

**WHEREAS**, Section 2.88.060(A) of Placer County Code currently requires that the board of supervisors review an emergency proclamation every 30 days, and

**WHEREAS**, the County Code should be consistent with State statutes.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF PLACER, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1:** Chapter 2, Article 2.88, Section 2.88.060(A) of the Placer County Code is amended to read as follows:

SEC. 2.88.060 Director and assistant director of emergency services – Powers and Duties

The director is empowered to:

- A. Request the board of supervisors to proclaim the existence or threatened existence of a “local emergency” if the board of supervisors is in session, or to issue such proclamation if the board of supervisors is not in session. Whenever a local emergency is proclaimed by the director, the board of supervisors shall take action to ratify the proclamation within seven days thereafter, or the proclamation shall have no further force or effect. The board of supervisors shall review the proclamation at least every sixty (60) days, or as Cal. Government Code Section 8630 may be amended from time to time, at least every thirty (30) days until such local emergency is terminated. The board of supervisors, ~~the need for continuing the local emergency and~~ shall proclaim the termination of such local emergency at the earliest date the conditions warrant.

**Section 2:** This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect thirty (30) days after its passage.

**Section 3:** The Clerk is directed to publish a summary of the ordinance within fifteen (15) days in accordance with Government Code Section 25124.
