WHEREAS, the Town of Truckee ("Town") is the lead agency with respect to the Truckee River Legacy Trail – Phase 4 ("Project"), and the County of Placer ("County") is a responsible agency because a portion of the Project is located in Placer County; and

WHEREAS, on July 9, 2019, the Town of Truckee Town Council conducted a public hearing and adopted a mitigated negative declaration ("MND") for the Project; and

WHEREAS, on July 16, 2019, the Town filed a Notice of Determination (NOD) in the office of the Nevada County Clerk-Recorder; and

WHEREAS, as a responsible agency, the County must review and consider the Town's Project MND and reach its own conclusions on whether and how to approve the portion of the Project in Placer County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Placer County Board of Supervisors ("Board") as follows:

- 1) Pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15096, the Board has reviewed and considered the information contained in the Project MND, finds the Project MND adequate for use by the County, and shall rely thereon with respect to its decision on the portion of the Project in Placer County.
- 2) The Board has considered the environmental effects of the Project as shown in the Project MND and finds that the mitigation measures set forth therein will reduce any potentially significant environmental effects to less than significant levels.
- 3) The Director of the Placer County Department of Public Works ("Director"), or designee, shall exercise oversight over the implementation of Project mitigation measures with respect to the portion of the Project located in Placer County.
- 4) The Director, or designee, shall file a Notice of Determination for the Project within five (5) working days of the Board's adoption of this resolution.
