WHEREAS, the State of California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) requires that the County of Placer manage and take responsibility of the maintenance and upkeep of the landscape improvements constructed in the Caltrans Right-of-way as part of the SR 89 Fanny Bridge Replacement Project. The improvements include two Gateway Monuments and illumination lighting installed on the Western and Eastern Roundabouts on State Route (SR) 89, and the paver sidewalks, landscape plantings, mulch, and irrigation systems installed on and around the Western and Eastern Roundabouts located on SR 89, and installed on and around the Wye Roundabout located on SR 28.

BE IT RESOLVED, the Placer County Board of Supervisors supports the Landscape Maintenance Agreement between Placer County and Caltrans for the SR 89/Fanny Bridge Replacement Project.
