

## Grant Program Now Open!

The Placer County Air Pollution Control District's Moyer and CAP Programs make available grants to private fleets and public agencies in order to clean up their heavy-duty fleets beyond what is required by law. Options include repowering or replacing vehicles and equipment with the cleanest engines available. Grants also fund infrastructure projects to support California's transformation towards zero and near-zero technologies.

### Grant possibilities include:

- Diesel to diesel equipment replacement
- Diesel to diesel, to CNG, or to electric heavy-duty vehicle and equipment replacements
- Electric charging stations for businesses and public agencies
- CNG or hydrogen fueling infrastructure
- Diesel agricultural pump electrification plus infrastructure

### Funding available for projects that reduce air pollution!

The Placer County Air Pollution Control District is seeking applications for its annual grant programs which are primarily designed to reduce smog related air pollution.

### Grant Project Categories Include:

- Heavy duty **off-road equipment replacements** (small off-road and agricultural fleets only)
- **Electric charging** and CNG or hydrogen fueling stations for private and public entities
- **School bus replacements** (diesel to diesel, diesel to electric)
- **Transit Bus Replacements** (diesel to electric)
- And more

The District's grant programs are competitively reviewed, and cost effectivity will be considered when determining project funding amounts. All projects selected for funding must primarily operate within Placer County.

### Application Submittal Time Frame:

**April 1, 2020 – June 30, 2020, 5 pm**
