SUBJECT: California Department of Public Health – Sexually Transmitted Diseases Program Agreement

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**ACTION REQUESTED**

Adopt a Resolution to approve a revenue agreement with the California Department of Public Health (CDPH) for the prevention and control of Sexually Transmitted Diseases in an amount not to exceed \$67,825 for the period of July 1, 2019 to June 30, 2024, and authorize the Director of Health and Human Services to sign the agreement with Risk Management and County Counsel concurrence and to sign subsequent amendments not to exceed \$6,785 consistent with the subject matter and scope of work with Risk Management and County Counsel concurrence.

**BACKGROUND**

The mission of the Sexually Transmitted Disease (STD) Control Branch is to reduce the transmission and impact of sexually transmitted diseases and viral hepatitis in California. The branch supports the prevention efforts by providing statewide leadership, guidance, training, technical assistance, surge capacity and safety net support for delivering services throughout the state. CDPH carries out this mission by collaborating with local health jurisdictions and stakeholders in the public and private sectors, including the provision of grant monies.

Key strategic targets for STD prevention and control are: implementation of case-based surveillance; assurance of timely access to quality clinical services; verification of appropriate STD treatment; investigation of reported cases, unusual diseases, or outbreaks; identification of a STD patient's sexual and social network contacts; referral for examination and/or treatment to prevent further disease transmission or complications; and, health education and health promotion activities to prevent STDs and enhance awareness of individuals at risk for STD, medical providers, and other service providers within the community.

**FISCAL IMPACT**

The grant amount of \$67,825 is funded with State Funds. The annual amount of \$13,565 is included in the FY 2019-2020 Budget and will be included in future budgets.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Director of Health and Human Services be authorized on behalf of the Placer County Board of Supervisors to sign the grant agreement 19-10552 with the California Department of Public Health for the Core STD Program Management Project for a contract total of \$67,825 for the period of July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2024, and authorize the Director of Health and Human Services to sign the agreement and subsequent amendments not to exceed \$6,782 of the original contract total amount, consistent with subject matter and scope of work and Risk Management and County Counsel concurrence.
