PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION OF CORNER FOUND; EVIDENCE AND METHOD USED TO IDENTIFY OR REESTABLISH

Found, 2 1/4" x 2 1/4" square-headed bolt with a 1" shaft 30" long, from which a 34" Black Oak with a cut-out scar that dates correctly N 19.5 E 33.7 feet. The 22" Yellow Pine has been obliterated by a road. This corner has long been used and has a 1944 K-tag on the Black Oak.



PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENTS REBUILT OR PERPETUATED

I set a 2" CIP in a rock mound and marked a 17" Douglas Fir N 81 E 17.5 feet, scribed "S 1/4 BT", and a 14" Black Oak N 84 W 3.7 feet, scribed "S 1/4 BT".


