WHEREAS, the Placer County Board of Supervisors has previously entered into an agreement with the Victim Compensation and Government Claims Board and desires to continue the program to expeditiously process claims for the unreimbursed losses of victims of crime.

WHEREAS, the California Victim Compensation and Government Claims Board has authorized and allocated \$40,000 for the establishment of a revolving fund in order to expedite payment of emergency expenses related funeral/burial expenses, relocation expenses and crime scene cleanup.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors, County of Placer, State of California that the District Attorney of the County of Placer is authorized to sign and submit the Standard Agreement between the California Victim Compensation Board and the County of Placer, and is further authorized to sign for purposes of making any extension or amendment thereof.
