IN THE MATTER OF A COMMENDATION RECOGNIZING ROSALINA MICLAT FOR THIRTY YEARS OF DEDICATED PUBLIC SERVICE AS AN EMPLOYEE OF PLACER COUNTY

WHEREAS, Rosalina Miclat is retiring from the County of Placer, Auditor-Controller's Office after serving the citizens of the County for 30 years; and

WHEREAS, Rosalina Miclat received her Bachelor of Science in Commerce in 1981 in the Philippines and was hired as an Account Clerk II – Extra Help in the Auditor-Controller's Office, Accounts Payable Division on December 26, 1990. Demonstrating a high level of proficiency and competence, she was hired as a permanent employee on May 4, 1991 in the Property Tax Division, and then transferred to the Warrants Division on July 1, 1991. Her supervisors found her to be approachable, open-minded and particularly successful at establishing and maintaining good relationships; and

WHEREAS, Rosalina was promoted to Account Clerk III on November 14, 1992. Due to her knowledge and warm personality, Rosalina was well prepared to work with staff at all levels of the organization. She conducted herself with confidence and listened carefully; she was articulate and persuasive; and she actively sought the absolute best possible outcome to every issue she addressed; and

WHEREAS, Rosalina assumed a significant role on many occasions, including promoting to the role of Senior Account Clerk on September 2, 1995. Rosalina later promoted to Accountant-Auditor I on May 12, 1997. It was at this time she transferred to the Payroll Division where she completed the Supervisory and Management series training; she then promoted to Senior Accountant-Auditor; and, eventually promoted to Payroll Manager. Rosalina was instrumental in providing her subject matter expertise to the Auditor-Controller's Office in the GDT payroll implementation, as well as the ACORN and Workday payroll implementations. Rosalina was also instrumental on the PAS project and was the lead on developing the bank reconciliation module. Each of these projects was highly complex, contributing to the success of Auditor staff and therefore the citizens of Placer County, while having a direct impact on the Auditor-Controller's day to day operations and the professionalism and welfare of our employees; and

WHEREAS, Rosalina Miclat's dedication to the Auditor-Controller's Office and to the citizens of Placer County has been exemplary. She has performed with professionalism, conscientious attention to detail and a wonderful sense of humor throughout her career.
