# Placer County's Attestation triggers are assuring

Placer Triggers	Threshold	Current Value
Doubling time of cases	<5 days for 5 straight days	~15 days
Hospital census	>135% licensed capacity	87%
Health care worker infections	Increasing for 5 days	None since 6/3
PPE for HCW	<7-day supply	>7-day supply
% of cases with contacts elicited	<80% of cases	>80%
% symptomatic contacts tested within 48 hours of symptoms	<90%	>90%

# Most of Placer County's State Monitoring Indicators are also assuring

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State Indicators	Threshold	Current Value
Case rate per 100k (14-day)	>25 (or >100 alone)	~27.4
Testing positivity rate (7-day)	>8%	2%
Change in 3-day average	>10% (only if n>20)	n<20
% ICU beds available	<20%	39%
% Ventilators available	<25%	88%
