SUBJECT: Contract Amendments for Mental Health Service Act (MHSA) Services

ACTION REQUESTED

1. Approve amendments to the contracts identified in Attachment 1 to extend the existing contracts from July 1, 2020 through September 30, 2020 increasing by \$2,241,974 for an aggregate amount not to exceed \$28,430,434.
2. Approve a one year contract amendment for Nancy M. Callahan, Ph.D dba I.D.E.A. Consulting to continue to provide Evaluation Consulting Services related to Mental Health, Substance Use Disorder Services and Child Welfare Services from July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2021, and increase compensation by \$150,000 for revised total not to exceed \$1,350,000 over the full term of the contract.
3. Authorize the Director of Health and Human Services to execute the agreements with Risk Management and County Counsel concurrence and to sign subsequent amendments not to exceed 10 percent of the total contract amount or \$100,000, whichever is less, consistent with the current agreement's subject matter and scope of work with Risk Management and County Counsel concurrence.

BACKGROUND

In 2004, California voters passed Proposition 63, the Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) establishing a county and community partnership to provide mental health services to those challenged with serious mental health issues, address the mental health needs of underserved populations, and prevent mental health issues from becoming more severe. From its first implementation in 2006, MHSA has effectively delivered community supports and intensive crisis services, housing and ongoing supports to the seriously mentally ill, and a host of well-researched, evidence-based prevention and early intervention programs, all without local county dollars.

The County's Campaign for Community Wellness, which functions as the County's required MHSA Steering and Approval committee and includes service recipients, community-based providers from many sectors, and various county agencies, has overseen and reviewed the progress of these contracts. Due to COVID-19 delays, the 2020-2023 MHSA Three Year Plan and proposed contracts resulting from the current MHSA RFP are not anticipated to come before the Board until September. These extensions will allow uninterrupted delivery of services consistent with the existing 2017-2020 MHSA Three Year Plan.

Descriptions of the contracts and dollar amounts applicable for the 90-day contract extensions are detailed in Attachment 1.

For several years Nancy M. Callahan, Ph.D., dba IDEA Consulting has successfully collaborated with Placer County to complete evaluations required by the Mental Health Services Oversight and Accountability Commission (MHSOAC), California Department of Health Care Services (DHCS), Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA), and California Department of Social Services (CDSS) for services provide to Placer County residents. Their technical assistance and subject matter expertise related to the Mental Health Services Act (MHSA), Specialty Mental Health, Substance Use Disorders Evaluation Services, and Child Welfare Improvement is a critical component of our Systems of Care. As such, the County wishes to ensure the continuation of these services for one additional year.

FISCAL IMPACT

Funding for the 11 contract amendments in the amount of \$2,241,974 has been included in the Department's FY 2020-21 Proposed Budget and the full amount is funded from Federal and State sources. No County General Funds are required.

Funding for Nancy M. Callahan, Ph.D dba I.D.E.A. Consulting in the amount of \$150,000 is included in the Department's FY 2020-21 Proposed Budget.
