SUBJECT: Cooperative Agreement for Glassy-Winged Sharpshooter Program

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**ACTION REQUESTED**

Adopt a resolution authorizing the Agricultural Commissioner to sign Cooperative Agreement #19-0727-013-SF with the California Department of Food and Agriculture for reimbursement of up to \$100,018 of costs under the Glassy-Winged Sharpshooter Program from July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2022.

**BACKGROUND**

The California Department of Food and Agriculture (CDFA) provides reimbursement for various programs under the direction of the Agricultural Commissioner to help offset the costs to counties for enforcing mandated programs.

Under this contract, the County will be reimbursed up to a maximum of \$100,018 from July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2022, for participating in the State's Glassy-Winged Sharpshooter Program for the prevention and/or control of this insect pest, which transmits Pierce's Disease to grapevines. The State first began contracting with Placer County for this program during the 1999-2000 fiscal year, and the program was formerly known as the Pierce's Disease Control Program.

**ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT**

This action is not a project as defined by California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") Guidelines section 15378. In addition, this action is categorically exempt under CEQA Guidelines, Sections 15306 (Information Collection) and 15061(b)(3) (Common Sense).

**FISCAL IMPACT**

This revenue reimbursement is for an ongoing program and has no impact on the General Fund.
