To Whom It May Concern:

We would like to take this opportunity to request the Board consider the following criteria and classify Anytime Fitness in Granite Bay as a Health Facility, essential to the health and wellness of the community at large in Placer County, allowing us to re-open under our very strict COVID criteria. Our family owned facility cannot maintain an extended closure. We have spent an immense amount of extra time and money to implement COVID protocol that will remain in the facility, even post COVID. Please consider the following and allow us to re-open as of August, 2020 so we do not have to close our doors permanently.

- **Anytime Fitness in Granite Bay has been opened since 2011**
 - Square Footage - ~6,000 sq. ft.
 - COVID Capacity – 45 members
 - PPV Members – 200
 - PPV members are members that pay per visit via their health insurance. Average age is 65+
 - Since re-opening June 12, 2020 – average usage/hour = 5 members
- **COVID Protocol**
 - (4) AERUS air purifiers certified for Space Technology
https://www.beyondbyaerus.com/globalassets/sellsheets/BGA_SS_BeyondGuardianAir_Main.pdf
 - Uses ActivePure[®] Technology to create pristine air quality and attack contaminants on surfaces
 - Ten unique features include technologies to capture 99.97% of particles as small as 0.01 micron (COVID-19 is .125 microns)
 - Thermometer on site. Staff is tested before each shift
 - Masks are provided
 - Single Use Gloves are provided
 - CINTAS EPA certified cleaning agent and touchless paper towels
 - Machines and equipment are cleaned after each use and additionally every hour by staff
 - Hand sanitizer and sanitizer wipes available throughout the facility
 - Members have limited to no contact with staff
 - Restrooms are cleaned regularly with the schedule posted on the door
 - Janitorial service weekly to sanitize and deep clean
- **Anytime Fitness survey results – July 2020 (California)**
 - 120 California Anytime Fitness facilities surveyed

- Member Data
 - 2,245,761 member check-in usage from June 12th-July 15th
 - Total members positive for COVID-19 = 44
 - Since opening June 12th, no COVID-19 cases have occurred in health clubs, gyms, or studios, thanks to safety standards including social distancing, wearing a mask/face covering, frequent washing of hands, and wiping/cleaning equipment
