SUBJECT: Ratification / Approval of Westcon Construction Company Invoice #4619 for Emergency Repairs

ACTION REQUESTED

Ratify Westcon Construction Company Invoice #4619 and authorize payment of \$37,205 for emergency water line repairs.

BACKGROUND

In September 2020, Parks and Grounds staff observed water flowing to the surface in the median area of Douglas Boulevard near Dover Drive in Granite Bay. The flow of water was determined to be related to the irrigation main that serves the planted area of the Douglas Blvd median. Upon exploration, it was determined that some localized erosion to the structural section of Douglas Blvd was emerging, and the water to the median had to be shut off until repairs could be made in order to avoid further damage to the roadway. Staff contacted Westcon Construction Company of Newcastle to review the work. Westcon proposed a price of \$35,450.00 to perform the repair including excavation, pipe repair, backfill, compaction, and repaving. On September 10, 2020, the Director of Public Works authorized Westcon to perform the work under the provisions of Purchasing Policy Section 3.7(B), "Department Level Emergency" in order to preserve the integrity of Douglas Boulevard and allow watering of the median to resume normally. During the course of work, one change order in the amount of \$1,755 was issued to place a new protective sleeve around the repaired pipe.

Per Purchasing Manual Section 6.2(B), the resulting \$37,205 invoice requires your Board's approval.

ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT

The repair work is statutorily exempt from California Environmental Quality Act review under CEQA Guidelines § 15269, "Emergency Projects," and is categorically exempt under CEQA Guidelines § 15301(c), "Existing Facilities."

FISCAL IMPACT

The total cost of the repair service is \$37,205. There are sufficient reserves within the Granite Bay Landscape CSA Zone of Benefit #120 to pay for the repair work.
