SUBJECT: Revenue Sharing – First United Methodist Church of Loomis, Loomis Basin Food Pantry – Funding to help offset the cost of food and gift cards for families in need

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**ACTION REQUESTED**

Approve appropriation of \$750 in Revenue Sharing monies to the First United Methodist Church of Loomis, Loomis Basin Food Pantry as requested by Supervisor Holmes (\$500) and Supervisor Uhler (\$250).

**BACKGROUND**

In approving the following contributions, the Placer County Board of Supervisors finds that each and every approved contribution serves a public purpose by promoting the general welfare of the County and its inhabitants, therefore a benefit results to the County.

The Board of Supervisors is being asked to approve appropriations to the First United Methodist Church of Loomis for the Loomis Basin Food Pantry (LBFP). The LBFP began in the 1980's when several local community members started a small food bank in a garage in Ophir. Today, there is a team of 10 volunteers who fill bags with food and deliver them to a local food closet for distribution. As a result of impacts related to COVID-19 community need is greater this year, however many local organizations have suspended food drives due to the virus. In order to ensure families in need are supported this holiday season the LBFP will be providing gift cards to help members of the Loomis Basin Community. Revenue Share funds will be used to help offset the cost providing gift cards for families in need.
