ACTION REQUESTED

Approve a Commendation recognizing Kirk Uhler for 18 years of service to Placer County as the District 4 Supervisor

BACKGROUND

Kirk Uhler was first elected to the Placer County Board of Supervisors in 1993 at the age of 25 years old, making him the second-youngest supervisor ever elected in California. Supervisor Uhler served as the District 4 Supervisor from 1993 to 1996, and in 2007 he was appointed by the Board of Supervisors to fill the seat vacated mid-term by then-District 4 Supervisor Ted Gaines. Since 2007 Supervisor Uhler has been elected by his peers to serve three consecutive terms as the District 4 Supervisor.

Supervisor Uhler’s contributions to his community and the county as a whole will benefit county residents and businesses for years to come. His unwavering commitment to fiscal responsibility and stewardship of Placer residents’ tax dollars formed helped to form the bedrock of the strong economic foundation Placer County continues to build upon today. Additionally, Supervisor Uhler’s leadership and dedication were key factors in the approval of both the Placer Ranch Specific Plan and Sunset Area Plan, and played a critical role in the successful completion of the Placer County Conservation Plan.

IN THE MATTER OF A COMMENDATION RECOGNIZING SUPERVISOR KIRK UHLER FOR HIS EIGHTEEN YEARS OF SERVICE TO PLACER COUNTY COMMUNITIES

WHEREAS, Kirk Uhler was first elected to the Placer County Board of Supervisors in 1993 at the age of 25 years old, making him the second-youngest supervisor ever elected in California, and served four additional terms as Supervisor of Placer County's Fourth Supervisorial District; and

WHEREAS, Supervisor Uhler has been a resident of Placer County since 1970, and a long-time community leader in Granite Bay, where he grew up and raised his own family; and

WHEREAS, Supervisor Uhler's unwavering commitment to fiscal responsibility and stewardship of Placer residents' tax dollars helped Placer County not only weather the 2008 recession, but recover quickly and go on to thrive, reinforcing the strong economic foundation Placer County continues to build upon today; and

WHEREAS, Supervisor Uhler's vision and leadership have been essential to the development and approval of the Placer Ranch Specific Plan and Sunset Area Plan, laying the groundwork for continued job creation, attainable housing and higher education opportunities; and

WHEREAS, Supervisor Uhler played a pivotal role in the successful completion of the Placer County Conservation Plan, a national model for balancing sustainable development and resource conservation that will enhance the efficiency and quality of both; and

WHEREAS, Supervisor Uhler served on the boards of the Placer County Transportation Planning Agency and the South Placer Regional Transportation Authority, and was an effective advocate for projects to relieve traffic congestion such as widening Auburn Folsom Road and the 65/80 Interchange Improvement Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE KNOWN, that the above COMMENDATION was duly passed by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Placer, on behalf of the citizens of Placer County, at a regular meeting held December 15, 2020, recognizing Supervisor Kirk Uhler for his many years of service and contributions to the Granite Bay community and Placer County.
