WHEREAS, the existing improvements at the intersection of North Shore Boulevard (State Route [SR] 267) and North Lake Boulevard (SR 28) within the unincorporated community of Kings Beach have been determined to be functionally obsolete, and

WHEREAS, a preliminary design for the project has been prepared at the direction of Placer County, and

WHEREAS, the design of the intersection reconfiguration and appurtenant improvements are consistent with the California Department of Transportation and Placer County Standards, and

WHEREAS, the County of Placer has prepared a Mitigated Negative Declaration, circulated it as required by law and included all necessary measures to mitigate any significant impacts of the project.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors, County of Placer, State of California, that this Board approves a Mitigated Negative Declaration (STATE CLEARINGHOUSE NO. 2020109003) for the Kings Beach Western Approach Project and makes the following findings:

1. The mitigated negative declaration has been prepared as required by law.
2. There is no substantial evidence in the record as a whole that the Project as mitigated may have a significant effect on the environment.
3. The Mitigated Negative Declaration as adopted for the Project reflects the independent judgment and analysis of Placer County, which has exercised overall control and direction of its preparation.
4. The mitigation plan / mitigation monitoring program prepared for the project is approved and adopted.
