SUBJECT: Single Case Agreements

ACTION REQUESTED

1. Ratify execution of a single case agreement with Sutter Bay Hospitals dba Alta Bates Summit Medical Center for inpatient eating disorder services beginning December 18, 2020 in an amount not to exceed \$100,000, and authorize the Director of Health and Human Services to sign subsequent amendments up to \$10,000, consistent with each agreement's subject matter and scope of work with Risk Management and County Counsel concurrence.
2. Ratify execution of a single case agreement with Bay Psychiatric Associates for enhanced level of psychiatric care services beginning December 18, 2020, in an amount not to exceed \$15,000, and authorize the Director of Health and Human Services to sign subsequent amendments up to \$1,500, consistent with each agreement's subject matter and scope of work with Risk Management and County Counsel concurrence.

BACKGROUND

The State Department of Health Care Services (DHCS), through the 1915 B waiver process with the Federal Centers for Medicare and Medi-Caid Services, requires local county Mental Health Plans to provide an array of services for Medi-Cal beneficiaries. These include inpatient, residential, and intensive outpatient services to address a variety of conditions including eating disorders. Eating disorders are highly complex conditions with both psychiatric and medical components, and the inpatient and outpatient facilities normally contracted with by Health and Human Services do not address this specialized need. This requires Placer County to enter into single case agreements, often at a very accelerated timeline, to ensure both the psychiatric, and medical components are addressed in a crisis situation.

Placer has one youth under the age of 18 who is in need of this specialized service at the inpatient level at this time requiring a single care agreement, and one adult who is in need of the intensive outpatient service at this time also requiring a single case agreement, but may have need for the inpatient specialized service in the near future.

Sutter Bay Hospitals dba Alta Bates Summit Medical Center is a provider of the specialized eating disorders treatment at the inpatient level. One single case agreement is needed for this placement. Bay Psychiatric Associates is the specially trained providers who work at Alta Bates Summit Medical Center to provide an enhanced psychiatric level of care. A second single case agreement is necessary for the youth to receive these specialized services.

FISCAL IMPACT

Funding for these mandated services is funded through a blend of Federal, State, and County General Fund dollars and is included in the Department's FY 2020-2021 Budget.

The agreements are on file with the Clerk of the Board for review.
