ACTION REQUESTED

Approve a budget revision to add Items #1 and #2 in the Fixed Asset List Attachment to the County's FY 2020-21 Master Fixed Asset List.

BACKGROUND

On September 11, 2018, your Board adopted a resolution authorizing the Director of Health and Human Services to sign and submit an application and related documents for the Homeless Mentally Ill Outreach and Training (HMIOT) funding as a result of Senate Bill (SB) 840. In October 2018, Placer County was sent a letter of acceptance from the Department of Health Care Services awarding an allocation of funding of \$307,000 from December 31, 2018 through June 30, 2020, for the Homeless Mentally Ill Outreach and Treatment Program. On June 22, 2020, the Department of Health Care Services extended the funding allocation end date through December 31, 2020.

The HMIOT funds were utilized for gaps in local services involving individuals with serious mental illness and who are homeless or at risk of homelessness. Some examples of what the funds were used for include; homeless outreach services, housing, employment assistance, transportation, mental health and/or treatment needs not covered by other funding, prevention of homelessness or the ending of homelessness. Two trailers were purchased by Placer County with the expectation to be signed over to individuals once they are identified as appropriate recipients to utilize the trailers as long term living environments. They will also need to be added to the Master Fixed Asset List.

FISCAL IMPACT

Funding is 100% State revenues and is included in the FY 2020-21 Budget.
