ACTION REQUESTED

Approve the reappointment of Joyce Bachman to Seat #1, George Alves to Seat #2, and Richard Lewis to Seat #3 on the Rural Lincoln Municipal Advisory Council.

BACKGROUND

The purpose of the Rural Lincoln Municipal Advisory Council (RLMAC) is to advise the Board of Supervisors on matters of concern that relate to the area served by the Council, including but not limited to land use, public health, safety, public works, law enforcement, and recreation. Additionally the Council shall advise the Board of Supervisors on matters specifically referred to it by the Board of Supervisors for review and recommendation. The Council is composed of five members appointed by the Board of Supervisors, each member serving two-year terms. Members shall, at the time of appointment and at all times during term of office, be residents, property owners of real property, or business owners or managers operating a business within the RLMAC boundaries. Failure to maintain such status shall result in a vacancy of office. The RLMAC meets the third Monday of each month at 7:00 p.m. at the Gold Hill Guild, 1405 Gold Hill Road, Newcastle, CA.

PUBLIC COMMITTEE

PURPOSE: The Municipal Advisory Council may advise the Board of Supervisors on matters of concern which relate to the area served by the Municipal Advisory Council, including but not limited to land use, public health, safety, public works, law enforcement, and recreation. In addition, the Council shall advise the Board of Supervisors on matters specifically referred to it by the Board of Supervisors for review and recommendation. The Council shall adopt rules, regulations and procedures as are reasonable and appropriate for its activity, as are specifically approved by the Board of Supervisors. The Council shall also comply with any rules, regulations, and procedures contained in the MAC Manual proscribed and approved by the Board of Supervisors. In absence of procedures to the contrary, the council shall be governed by Robert’s Rules of Order. The Council shall keep all record of its actions in a form prescribed by the Placer County Auditor.

COMPOSITION: Five (5) members, appointed by the Board of Supervisors. Members shall own real property within the area, or own or operate a business within the area. Terms shall be for two years.

COMPENSATION: All members of the Council shall serve without compensation.
