RE : Re-Appointments to Law Library Board of Trustees

ACTION REQUESTED:

Re-appoint Karin Schwab or designee and Preston Marx to the Law Library Board of Trustees.

BACKGROUND:

The Placer County Law Library was established under state law and is governed by an independent Board of Law Library Trustees. California Business & Professions Code Section 6301 sets out the constitution of the Board of Trustees, which is a seven (7) person Board comprised of five (5) members or appointments from the Superior Court and two (2) from the Board of Supervisors. As to the Board of Supervisors, the statute identifies one seat for the Chair of the Board or designee and the second seat for a Board of Supervisors appointee.

Your Board has traditionally appointed/designated a representative from the County Counsel's office to the seat allocated to the Chair. The second appointment from your Board has traditionally been a local, licensed, and active member of the California State Bar and to that end, in 2020, your Board appointed Preston Marx to this second seat. Mr. Marx has served in this capacity during 2020 and has expressed an interested to continue to serve on the Library Board during 2021. Mr. Marx is a resident of Meadow Vista, licensed to practice in California and is a Certified Specialist in Estate Planning. He is an associate with the Burton Law Firm with offices in Roseville and Sacramento. His application is on file with the Clerk of the Board.

We are seeking reappointment of both our office and Mr. Marx to the Law Library Board of Trustees for 2021.
