SUBJECT: Contract with BREa Citrus Heights LLC

ACTION REQUESTED

Approve an agreement with BREa Citrus Heights LLC to provide residential care services in an amount not to exceed \$102,000 for the period of August 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021 and authorize the Director of Health and Human Services to sign the agreement with Risk Management and County Counsel concurrence, and sign subsequent amendments up to \$10,200, consistent with the agreement's subject matter and scope of work with Risk Management and County Counsel concurrence.

BACKGROUND

BREa Citrus Heights LLC is licensed through the California Department of Social Services, Community Care Licensing Division as a Residential Care Facility for the Elderly (RCFE). One of the services that Placer County Adult System of Care (ASOC) may provide for Public Guardian clients, is to ensure basic needs are met for individuals who struggle with significant cognitive impairments as a result of dementia or Alzheimer's, and have been deemed unable to provide for their basic needs (e.g. food, clothing and shelter) under Probate Conservatorship. Currently, there are 48 individuals receiving services under Probate Conservatorship. This contract will offer Conservatees, who are at risk of wandering or becoming lost, abuse, and undue influence a safe environment through a secure residence.

BREa Citrus Heights LLC is a licensed Residential Care Facility for the Elderly (RCFE) that offers a home-like environment where residents receive more personalized care, including assistance with activities of daily living (e.g. grooming, eating, and dressing), medication management and small organized group activities unique to the residents' lives.

FISCAL IMPACT

Expenditures will be included in the Department's FY 2020-21 Budget. Funding for this contract is 100% County General Fund.

The agreement is on file with the Clerk of the Board for review.
