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**ACTION REQUESTED**

Approve appropriation of \$1,000 in Revenue Sharing monies to support The Lazarus Project as requested by Supervisor Gore (\$500), Supervisor Weygandt (\$250), and Supervisor Jones (\$250).

**BACKGROUND**

In approving the following contributions, the Placer County Board of Supervisors finds that each and every approved contribution serves a public purpose by promoting the general welfare of the County and its inhabitants, therefore a benefit results to the County.

The Board of Supervisors is being asked to approve appropriations to The Lazarus Project, a nonprofit organization that provides housing to homeless men and women in our community who are striving to build a more stable future for themselves. The organization also helps the people they serve to become self-sufficient and helps the community address the affordable housing crisis. Revenue Share contributions will be used to help offset the cost of repairs needed at one of the facilities that provides housing to homeless men in Placer County.

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
