SUBJECT: Amendment with California Department of Public Health (CDPH) for Immunization Outreach Program

ACTION REQUESTED

Adopt a Resolution to approve additional funds to a revenue agreement with the California Department of Public Health for the Immunization Outreach Program in an amount not to exceed \$122,141 for a contract total not to exceed \$661,560 for the period of July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2022, and authorize the Director of Health and Human Services to sign the agreement with Risk Management and County Counsel concurrence, and top sign subsequent amendments not to exceed \$66,156 consistent with subject matter and scope of work with Risk Management and County Counsel concurrence.

BACKGROUND

Placer County has been receiving State funds from the California Department of Public Health for the Immunization Outreach Program since the mid-1990s. This agreement requires the Health Officer to organize and maintain a program to make required immunizations available to the community including vaccines at low or no cost. The contract will continue enabling Placer County to promote, support and improve community vaccine access by providing participating community vaccine providers with no cost vaccines, educational materials, media vaccine campaigns or participation in local clinics.

Additionally, the California Immunization Program has led the efforts to plan and distribute Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19) vaccine throughout the state of California. The increased funding provided to Placer County will support these continued efforts to ensure influenza and COVID-19 vaccination coverage. Significant efforts are already underway throughout the county to ensure residents have access to COVID-19 vaccine in alignment with the distribution tiering model led by the California Department of Public Health, and the additional funding will support the sustainment of this work.

FISCAL IMPACT

Funding for this agreement is 100% State funding from the California Department of Public Health and is included in the FY 2020-21 and FY 2021-22 budgets.
